Please be advised that on Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> 2009, from 8:15 am until 12:00 noon, a Cooperative Extension Program of the Land Grant Universities and the County will be giving away sugarcane seed stock. There are several varieties, which include mainly syrup cane. See list at the end of document.

Each registered person is allowed to cut 20 stalks of each variety. You will need to bring your own cutting instruments to cut the cane stocks. For those who pass through agriculture checks with the cane, a disclosure statement will be given out at the site.

The event will take place at North Florida Research and Education Center in Quincy, on Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> 2009, starting at 8:15 am until 12:00 noon. It is advisable to arrive early, because it will be on a first come first serve basis.

A **registration fee of \$ 8.00 will be charged per participant.** For additional information contact the Gadsden County Extension Service at 850-875-7255.
